Role 2 – base character – Old Mother Redbeard. A wily woman who for many years now has lived in the heart of the forest alongside and with nature. She has the best mushroom recipe ever! At first she appears frightening / weird / unusual but we discover that there is more to OMRB than meets the eye.

Here at Funnelwick Limb we love telling stories by any means we can!

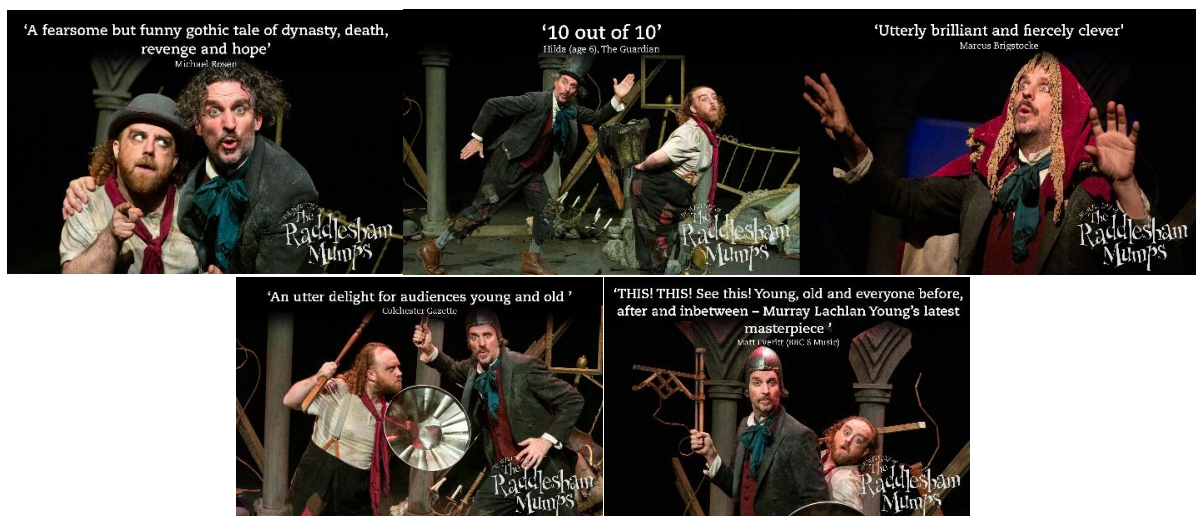
We tell stories on stages, in books and online.
